Resolution is requesting that the City of Los Angeles include in its 2019-2020 State Legislative Program OPPOSITION to SB 50, which would allow construction of higher density multi-family housing developments near major transit stops that are out-of-compliance with local land use regulations and procedures, unless amended to exclude the City of Los Angeles from its provisions.
