**Council File 19-0002-S151, HR 1856 (Waters) / The Ending Homelessness Act of 2019 / Homeless Housing / Funding:** Introduced on August 9, 2019 and referred to Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee. The Resolution is requesting the City of Los Angeles to include in its 2019-2020 Federal Legislative Program SUPPORT for HR 1856 (Waters), The Ending Homelessness Act of 2019 which would provide over \$13 billion over five years for homeless housing and services nationwide, including permanent supportive housing, rental assistance, outreach, and case management.
