The North Hills West Neighborhood Council at its November 16, 2023, General Board Meeting, as duly posted by the Brown Act, voted as follows:

The North Hills West Neighborhood Council (NHWNC) supports the City's Resolution to authorize Neighborhood Councils to offer teleconferencing or virtual meetings and to authorize North Hills West NC to use teleconferencing for Neighborhood Council Board Meetings and Committee Meetings in accordance with the rules established by Senate Bill 411 and the subsequent motion passed by the City Council on November 1, 2023. The special teleconferencing rules available to Los Angeles Neighborhood Councils. The NHWNC requests the Department of Neighborhood Empowerment (DONE) or another appropriate City agency support the North Hills West Neighborhood Councils with equipment to facilitate technologically integrated in-person, hybrid, and/or virtual meetings.

Justification: The NWNC elects to adopt the resolution the use of teleconferencing for some or all of its Board and/or Committee meetings pursuant to Government Code Section 54953.8(a) for Increased accessibility, increased community engagement, health and safety of the participants, lack of childcare and making Quorum to hold Board Meetings; otherwise, meetings will be canceled due to not making Quorum.
