Sample question(s):

1. What do you think about aggressive drivers
  - a. Red light runners
  - b. Stop sign runners
  - c. Obscured car license plates
  - d. Curbing, tailgating, etc
  
2. Motorhomeless (PEH)
  - a. Sanitary (holding tank) leaks onto the street
  - b. Flammability hazards and recurring small fires
  - c. Associated persons experiencing behavioral emergencies
  - d. ADA blocked sidewalks
  - e. Long term stationary preventing street cleaning operations
  
3. Elections
  - a. Voters who vote incorrectly
  - b. Potential voters who don't vote but complain about things
  
4. Neighborhood Councils
  - a. Board, Committee and Stakeholders that ongoing-ly contribute
  - b. Board, Committee and Stakeholders that attend but don't contribute
  - c. Those that attend, don't contribute, but complain about those that do contribute
  - d. Those that don't attend, but would be great if they did
