Help Individuals Find Shelter

LA-HOP allows you to request help for unhoused neighbors by dispatching trained outreach teams to the reported area. This service not only sends an outreach team but also provides status updates from start to finish. Requests must be submitted online and may take a few days for a response.

- Organize Community Clean-Ups
- Host Resource Fairs for Housing, Healthcare & Employment
